DURATION

40 minutes

AUDIENCE

Free to all audiences

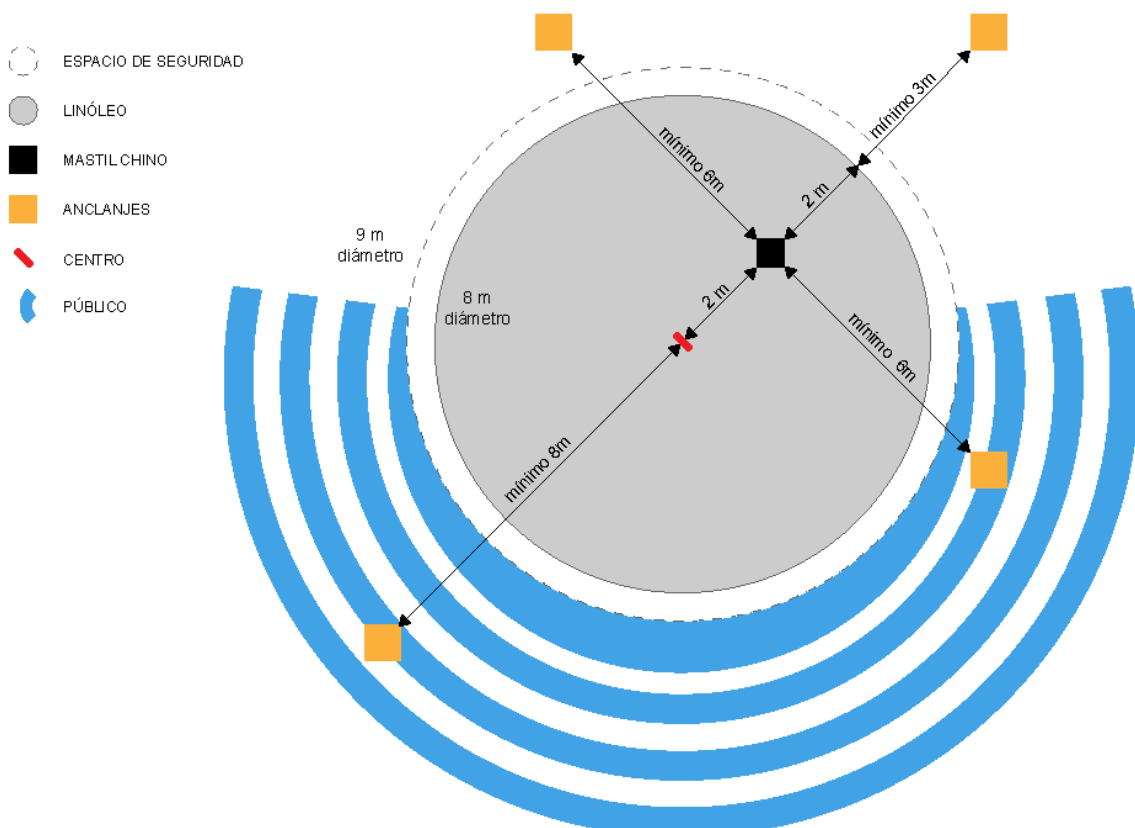
STAGE

- Circular stage space of 8m of diameter.
- Minimum height of 6metres free of obstacles.
- Flat, paved ground without relief. It can not be a ground of earth, gravel or grass.
- Gradient below 3%

ANCHORAGE

- Four points of anchorage on the ground in shape of a square or three points in shape of an equilateral triangle.
- Each point of anchorage has to have a minimum resistance of 750kg.
- The points of anchorage can be counterweights (for example : pieces of concrete, water-filled drums, trees, ...). In case of using counterweights it is necessary to contact the company in order to determine the exact position.
- There is also the possibility to hammer in stakes

Square-shaped anchorage:



SET UP

4 hours before the show for set up, soundcheck and warm up routines.

TAKEDOWN

1 hour approximately. It is necessary that the stage is illuminated until the end of takedown and that it can be accessed with a van.

SOUND

In the care of the organization

AFORAMENT

Sufficient chairs or stands for a good capacity, taking into account the foreseen audience.

ACCES

- Access for a 2m x 2m x 5m van (width, height, length)
- Parking or safe place where to park the van during the days of the performances.

OTHER NEEDS

- Water bottles since the start of set up.
- Dressing room with shower for after the show.
- Barriers to mark out the area behind the stage.
- A 220V/16A power outlet.
